-Title	The European Commission in the COVID 19 crisis: unpredictability, uncertainty, adaptability
-Summary of the main contents	<p>1. <u>Presentation of the context</u> : the Covid-19 crisis and its consequences at the European level (the first pandemic to affect all EU countries at the same time in a globalized world and in the internet age).</p> <p>2. <u>Reactions from the European Commission</u> at regional policy level : In the first place, “isolated” national actions instead of a common response → since the EU has no competence in health (it is attributed to Member States) Lack of Member States / Commission dialogue : each country takes care of its own competence - what about the Union, why is the Commission doing nothing ? However, it has been the subject of specific programmes. How is cooperation organized then ?</p> <p>3. <u>Presentation of the small programmes set up by the EC</u> in February / March in reaction to covid19 : -the Coronavirus Response Investment Initiative (CRII) -the Coronavirus Response Investment Initiative Plus (CRII +) -REACT-EU → for health, medical equipment, partial unemployment, buying masks In priority And as well the use of funds for health, cooperation - different from CRII and CRII +. The Commission has implemented a new generation of programmes (2021-2027).</p> <p>4. <u>Analysis</u> : how to react and adapt. Impact on economic disruption, mobility, interpersonal relations, “building walls instead of removing bridges” → requires the adaptation of public policies to covid.</p> <p>5. <u>Example</u> : look at a particular territory (example: Franco-Italian cross-</p>

	<p>border cooperation with Alcotra and Maritimo, or POCTEFA, or something else – <i>yet to be defined</i>)</p> <p>6. <u>Unpredictability</u> : how to react together when facing a situation that no one had foreseen.</p> <p>7. <u>Uncertainty</u> : how to work together when the situation is uncertain.</p> <p>8. <u>Adaptation</u> : how to adapt to an unprecedented situation.</p> <p><u>Conclusion</u> : Debate about the need to build a real Europe of health especially by/for our generation : from the covid-19 health crisis to a Europe of health: dream or illusion?</p>
